




MT103 - (Customer Credit Transfer)

Field 79 → Maximum number of character 50 X 35





FORMAT VALIDATION MT103 AND MT199

- 1. Format purpose code (separator and invoice information) used is limited on number, letter and special character allowed by SWIFT and Bank Indonesia.
- Transaction code on format purpose code can be for export/import/non export-import transaction; for export transaction which is not in accordance with the format required, Bank will not continue the payment to beneficiary's account;
- Invoice amount in field 70 MT103 and field 79 MT199 is equal or less than amount in field 32A MT103 (subfield interbank settled amount).
- If the usage of MT199 is more than 1 message, the completion of field 21 MT199 is same with field 20 MT103.
- The continued invoice information in field 70 MT103 and field 79 MT199, shall be input in one unit of invoice before the additional code (+).

Example: XYZ123(100000)+ \rightarrow correct; XYZ123+ \rightarrow wrong
